After the volcanoes became extinct some 400 million years ago leaving granite on some islands, the glaciations carved their features on the land, the Gulf of Maine & Bay of Fundy.This is a pristine area for ecological exploration by modern day eco- tourists with their backpacks, bicycles, kayaks, canoes & sail boats, and often relying on public transportation to reach their destinations. We encourage your eco visit & will arrange to pick you up whether at airport,bus,train or ferry. Foreign students' cultural contribution welcome. The property has a colorful history- it was a 100 acre pre-Revolutionary War Bounty to a Privateer who participated in the Boston Tea Party and the Castine Expedition. The land stretched from Mount Megunticook to Penobscot Bay. Walk for miles along the rock- strewn beaches, w/multiple public access points.including at Camden Hills State Park & Lincolnville Beach.. In the mid 1800's the Perrin- Freemans raised horses here for the Coastal Stagecoach & had an early gristmill on Spring Brook.which cascades into the ocean.. The Antique pre-1800 central chimneyed Original Farmhouse had a row of barns attached for overwintering livestock. In 1900 a Bangor doctor,timber baron & philanthropist converted the barns into a second dwelling (the "Carriage House"). . Freestanding barns and a greenhouse were added . . Substantial land was donated to the Camden Hills State Park which adjoined the property. The farm while retaining only six acres now has views of fields,horses grazing, Mount Megunticook, Penobscot Bay & its many ferry-connected islands (including Isleboro,North Haven & Vinal Haven).. On a clear day one may see Blue Hill .Isle Le Haut, & even Cadillac Mtn at Acadia Nat'l Park.. Windjamming schooners dot the Bay,inviting you for a few hours, or an extended ecological cruise to watch seals,dolphins porpoises,birds, an

occasional whale, & lobsterboats tending their traps..

LODGING Seaginger Backpacker Lodge perpetuates the spirit of early occupants and philanthropist renovator in offering an affordable cultural experience for ecologically oriented tourists, especially hikers,cyclists,kayakers, canoeists; also sailors needing crew quarters & tents needing to dry out..The ORIGINAL FARMHOUSE on the north side has Wyeth prints of Maine in every room. It offers a pewter blue ensuite downstairs B-B type room w/ twin beds,& private shower; just 3 steps up w/hand railings it is fairly handicap accessible..It adjoins the Butler's Pantry. The latter opens up into the Main Kitchen w/ 2 electric ovens & range, & double door frig-freezer. This leads to a sunny Breakfast Room.. On the first floor (wheel chair accessible) is a huge wall-papered Living Room w/book shelves & windows on three sides, and baby grand piano.
